

## Guidelines to fill Intermediate Grade Point (GP) marks and JEE percentile

**Board of Intermediate Education, A.P.** has declared results on GP in 2019. Students of A.P Board are advised to fill the 2nd Year marks in the online application form by choosing GP system. Then they can enter the grade and grade points obtained in each subject of the **Second Year**. Also, the grand total (GP) in the bottom should be entered.

For the purpose of Stream 1 and Stream 2 Rankings we will consider the total GP secured by the student. If there is a tie, we will consider Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry's GP of second year to ascertain the rank in order of merit.
